



The Courts at BC: Rules & Policies

Hours: 7 AM - 10:30 PM

Reservations

- ❖ Reservations can be made online at www.bellcanyon.com/tenniscourts at any time or by phone between 8 AM and 3 PM, Mondays – Fridays, with the BCA Office
- ❖ Reservations can be made anywhere between 7 days and 30 minutes in advance of play time
- ❖ Reservation length is between 30 and 90 minutes
- ❖ Only one reservation is allowed, per day, per household
- ❖ Reservations are confirmed by a BCA staff member before being added to the calendar
- ❖ Reservations can be confirmed by a BCA staff member **Mondays – Fridays between 8 AM and 3 PM ONLY**
- ❖ Reservations and unreserved court times may be viewed at www.bellcanyon.com/whoisplaying
- ❖ Players under the age of 11 must be accompanied by an adult
- ❖ Two players must arrive within 5 minutes of their reservation time to hold the court
- ❖ If two players do not arrive for their reserved court within 5 minutes of their reserved starting time, the reservation is considered cancelled, and other players may use the court
- ❖ An unreserved court is available for free play, for a maximum of 90 minutes, on a first-come, first-serve basis

Court Etiquette

- ❖ Only tennis may be played on the tennis court
- ❖ Dogs are never permitted within the tennis court enclosure
- ❖ Food, glass containers, and animals are never permitted within the tennis court enclosure
- ❖ Skateboards, bicycles, rollerblades or skates, and scooters are never permitted on the tennis courts
- ❖ Soft-soled "tennis shoes" must be worn on the courts: no bare feet or street shoes, including sandals, are permitted
- ❖ Lighting timers can be used to turn the court lights on for up to 90 minutes at a time between dusk and 10:30 PM; the master timer automatically shuts off all lights at 10:30 PM

Instructors

- ❖ Paid tennis instructors are allowed to conduct lessons, provided that they have registered with the BCA Office. To register, an instructor must provide the BCA office with:
 - A current CPR certificate
 - A signed "Release and Indemnification Agreement"
 - A current liability insurance policy for at least \$1 million naming BCA as an additional insured
- ❖ Instructors must arrange in advance to pay any defined service fee to the Association
- ❖ Instructors must agree to adhere to all of the rules and regulations of BCA

Cancellation policy

If you need to cancel your reservation, please do so online, or contact the office as soon as you are aware that you will need to so that others may play on that court. Your consideration is appreciated.
